Section 60 of the *Administrative Review Tribunal Act 2024* states that a person who is the decision maker for a reviewable decision may give the Tribunal written notice not to participate in a kind of Tribunal proceeding or a kind of Tribunal case event in relation to a kind of Tribunal proceeding. You should use this form to provide the Tribunal with written notice.

WHAT DO WE DO WITH INFORMATION GIVEN TO US?

We collect information from you to process your application and to carry out the review under the *Administrative Review Tribunal Act 2024*.

We give a copy of the form to the department or organisation that made the decision you want reviewed. We may also give a copy to any other person that is a party to the review.

If you give us other information during the review that another party does not have, we will usually give them a copy.

Limited information about is usually made available to the public on request and can be accessed using *eCase Search* on our website. This information includes the names of the parties and any representatives, the type of application, dates of conferences, hearings or other case events, the types of key documents lodged by the parties and the outcome of an application.

More information is usually made publicly available if we hold a hearing and make a decision. If we prepare a written statement of the reasons for our decision in your case, it will usually be made public and published on the internet, including on the AustLII website (www.austlii.edu.au).
